St Gemma's Hospice cares for seriously ill patients and their families, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Our dedicated nursing and medical teams know that when time is limited, every day matters. That's why we try to meet each person's individual needs, and deliver the right level of care to make every day special.

No two days are the same at St Gemma's Hospice. Sometimes, the nursing team pull out all the stops for a special occasion. When one



patient, Les, told us he wished he could take his wife Sheila out for afternoon tea, our nurses enlisted the help of Betty's Tea Rooms in Harrogate, to provide a tea party to remember at his bedside, with a selection of delicious cakes and pastries.

We also recognise that many people would prefer to stay in the comfort of their own home for as long as possible. However, coping at home with serious illness can be lonely and isolating. Our Community



and Day Hospice services aim to support people in this situation. Our Community Nurse Specialists visit patients at home, providing advice and support with pain relief and symptom management. A visit to the Day Hospice is often

the highlight of someone's week, providing the companionship and friendship of people in a similar situation and the opportunity to enjoy creative and complementary therapies, like art work, massage and aromatherapy.

Every day, in so many different ways, St Gemma's Hospice is trying to make a difference to the lives of seriously ill people and their families.

The care provided by St Gemma's Hospice is free of charge to patients and their families, but our services depend on the donations and fundraising activities of the local community. Can you sponsor a day or a weekend of care at the Hospice?

Sponsoring a day is a wonderful way for you to commemorate a day that's special for you whilst supporting St Gemma's Hospice. You could choose a day which holds your own treasured memories or a significant anniversary or birthday. Your donation will be used to help us provide nursing and medical care in our In-Patient Unit, our Day Hospice and through our community nursing team.

If your donation is in memory of a loved one, we will display a special certificate on our Hospice Reception bearing both your names on the day you have sponsored. You are welcome to visit the Hospice on your special day, to spend some time in our Chapel or the Hospice gardens. Many people also take this opportunity to write their thoughts in the Book of Remembrance.

To sponsor a day of care at St Gemma's Hospice is £350 or to sponsor a weekend of care is £700. Sponsoring a day or weekend of care can be done in one single donation by cash, cheque, credit or debit card, or alternatively you can spread the cost with a monthly direct debit for one year.
