Programme: June - July 2024

Do you provide support or care for people with a terminal illness, long-term condition or old age and frailty? This programme will help you to gain an understanding of palliative and end of life care, develop your skills and apply them to your practice.

The programme is taught by experts and clinicians working in palliative and end of life care and you will be supported in practice by a work-based mentor. Learning will be a mix of online and classroom based teaching with interactive activities and simulated scenarios.

Who is the programme for:

This programme is ideal for Health and Social Care Professionals who are new to palliative and end of life care or who want to refresh their knowledge. This includes: Health Care Assistants and Support Workers; Registered Nurses and Nursing Associates; Allied Health Care Professionals; and Social Workers.

The programme is taught at an equivalent level to a level 3 qualification (e.g 'A' level) and can be used as evidence for Continuing Professional Development (CPD).
